Council President D’Loss:

This is a public meeting on the matter of the Comprehensive Plan which includes the Borough of Carnegie, Heidelberg Borough, and Scott Township. The purpose of this meeting is to inform and take any public comment on the proposed adoption of Resolution 2012-02.

Solicitor Joe Lucas:

Resolution 2012-02: A Resolution of the Borough of Carnegie adopting a joint comprehensive plan between the borough of Carnegie, borough of Heidelberg and Scott Township, County of Allegheny, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania. This resolution enables mutual cooperation and multi municipal planning for the three mentioned municipalities. Is there any input President D’Loss?

Council President D’Loss:

Since there are some roadways and waterways that run through all three municipalities – it is prudent to have a Comprehensive Plan regarding community development. The Comprehensive Plan’s purpose is a long-term vision for the community. It is an overall comprehensive plan looking five to thirty years

Does Carnegie already have a Comprehensive Plan?

Yes, the current plan will be replaced by the new Comprehensive Plan.

Solicitor Joe Lucas:

How did the Comprehensive Plan come about?

Council President D’Loss:

It was an eighteen month process facilitated by an organization. Meetings and public hearings were held through the entire process.

Solicitor Joe Lucas:

Who was on the committee from Carnegie?

Council President D’Loss:

Myself, Chief Jeffrey Harbin, Councilwomen Covi, and Leigh White.

Solicitor Joe Lucas:

Any questions from any of the council members?

Councilwomen Covi:

No questions – I would like to comment on how handicap accessible Carnegie Borough is compared to the surrounding municipalities and I think the Comprehensive Plan will be fabulous.

Councilman Sarsfield:

Comment – the comprehensive plan should be update every several years and we are very fortunate with the timing and cost sharing of the new Comprehensive Plan.

Mayor Kobistek:

Comment – the Comprehensive Plan is important as to how it is connecting all three communities. I’d also like to thank Council President D’Loss for all of his hard work.
