

**New Parking Ordinance Regulating the Parking of Commercial
Vehicles
Borough Ordinance No. 2361**

On November 14th, 2011, Borough Council enacted an Ordinance that will prohibit the parking of Commercial Motor Vehicles on Borough streets between the hours of 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM. This Ordinance will take affect on January 14th, 2012.

For the purpose of this Ordinance, a Commercial Motor Vehicle is defined as:

- Any vehicle having a registered gross weight of 9,500 pound or more
- Has more than four (4) wheels in contact with the road surface
- Has a dump mechanism attached to the vehicle, or part of the vehicle
- Is a vehicle that is part of a fleet of vehicles with a primary use for business
- Campers, recreational vehicles, or mobile homes
- A bus

This Ordinance will not apply to any vehicle owned and operated by a person with a Handicapped Plate/Placard, or Disabled Veteran License Plate.

The penalty for violating this Ordinance shall be a \$100.00 for the first violation in a twelve month period, \$400.00 for the second violation in a twelve month period and \$1,000.00 for the third and each subsequent violation within a twelve month period.

We are asking all residents who are parking a Commercial Motor Vehicle (as described above) on a Borough street, alley, roadway, boulevard, drive or avenue, between the hours of 9:00 PM and 7:00 AM, to take notice of this prohibition that will begin on January 14th, 2012, and begin to make alternative arrangements for these vehicles.
