Peripheral Arterial Disease Screening - Ankle-Brachial Index (ABI) test using blood pressure cuffs on arms and legs. Important screening because PAD increases the risk of coronary artery disease, heart attack, or stroke.

Abdominal Aortic Aneurysm (AAA) - Ultrasound is performed to screen the abdominal aorta for the presence of an enlargement or aneurysm. AAA can lead to a ruptured aortic artery, which is a serious medical emergency.

Atrial Fibrillation - A 6-lead electrocardiogram (EKG) is performed by placing sensors on the arms and legs to screen for Atrial Fibrillation. AFib can lead to blood clots, stroke, and heart failure, and other heart-related complications.
